
Mr. Scuggs,

This letter is in response to your request for information regarding Carver Heights Senior Center in Havana, Florida. With the formation of Gadsden Senior Services in 2005, the accounts showed that there were monies in a separate account for a Havana Senior Center. Then Board President Jim Kellum stated there was some unwritten agreement between the former Gadsden County Senior Citizens Council and Havana for that money. From May 2005 to March 2007 GSS allocated those funds for labor support services until which point that money was depleted. Carver Heights Board of Directors President Norwood was informed both verbally and in writing and offered no opposition to our actions.

The GSS Board and I personally offered to continue to work with Carver Heights by joining forces, however; as the organization was a stand alone corporation registered with the State of Florida, as Carver Heights was receiving monies through fundraising and Havana City budgets unbeknownst to GSS and as Carver Heights did not wish to comply with regulations and standards set forth by the Department of Elder Affairs, GSS closed the fiscal books on Carver Heights Senior Center Incorporated.

I trust this will satisfy your inquiry.
