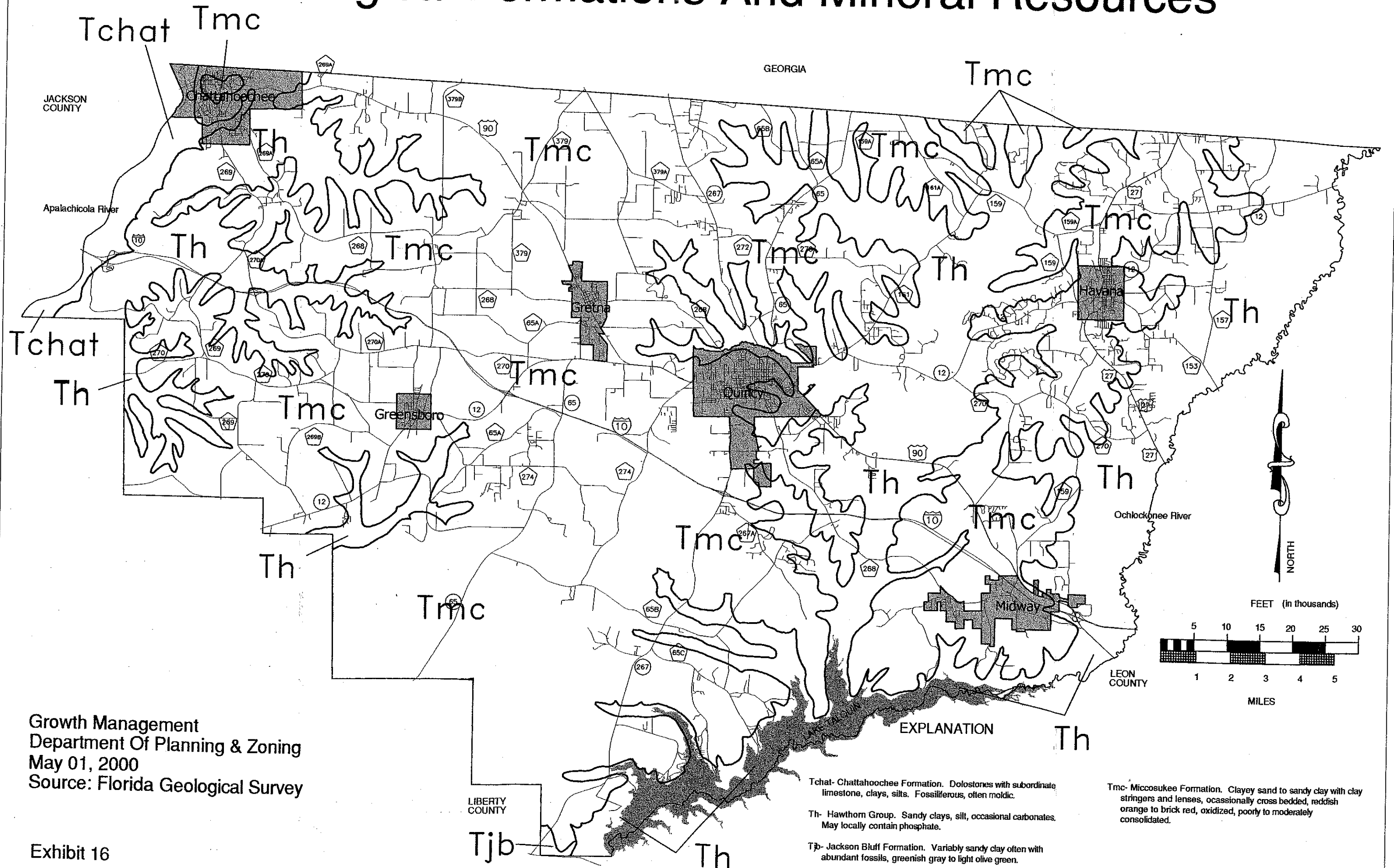

Tchat- Chattahoochee Formation. Dolostones with subordinate limestone, clays, silts. Fossiliferous, often moldic.

Th- Hawthorn Group. Sandy clays, silt, occasional carbonates. May locally contain phosphate.

Tjb- Jackson Bluff Formation. Variably sandy clay often with abundant fossils, greenish gray to light olive green.

Tmc- Micosukee Formation. Clayey sand to sandy clay with clay stringers and lenses, occasionally cross bedded, reddish orange to brick red, oxidized, poorly to moderately consolidated.
